CERTIFICATION OF PLACEMENT

In accordance with Article D. 124-9 of the Education Code, a placement certificate is issued to every pupil or student by the crew or the host organisation.

This document must be completed and signed on the last day of the workplace based training period by an authorised officer of the crew or the host organisation and then given to the trainee.

It is **mandatory** for the pupil or student to submit the original copy of the work-study placement certificate to the managing board of their training establishment, in addition to keeping a copy. This copy must then be sent on by the student to the DIRM (Direction interrégionale de la Mer – Interregional Marine Board) at the time at which they apply for the first navigation licence. A copy is also provided to the Maritime Examinations Office, to be included in the CCF file, in order to validate the student's curriculum.
